TASTING NOTE

An intensely structured wine expressing the depth and classic power of Cabernet Sauvignon driven blends from 2007. The high level of Shiraz and Malbec add density and softens the wine, finishing with a typical dry and refreshing palate due to Cabernet Franc and Sangiovese.
