



## 2013 Waterford Estate Rose-Mary

Cultivars: 5 Varietal Blend (Shiraz, Mourvedre, Malbec, Grenache and Merlot)

Type: Blanc de Noir

Production Area: Stellenbosch

### Description:

A lovely transparent pink colour. Aroma is minerally driven with delicate raspberry fruit undertones. The well intergrated acid leads to an elegantly tangy textured mouthfeel with a characterist dry finish with a low alcohol content.

### Vintage Review:

A long and cold winter, 35% more rain than usual. An excellent growing season until storm winds hit late October (up to 118km/hr) causing excessive damage in the vineyards, crop losses of up to 60%. Odd showers during second half of harvest giving reds a longer hang time. Outstanding white wines, in particular Chardonnay. Red wines came out with lovely soft textures and richness.
