Description:

A wine produced by whole bunch pressing various red grape varieties, this giving the wine a lovely transparent pink colour. The aroma is mineral driven with delicate raspberry fruit undertones. The natural acidity from the different mediterranean varieties add a lovely soft texture to the wine and provides for a crisp and delicate finish. The perfect low alcohol wine to be enjoyed alongside summer dishes.

Vintage review 2018

Another tough vintage for South African wineries as severe drought conditions continue. Early ripening varieties more affected as they are harvested in the middle of summer, with later ones being hardier during this period. Whites and blanc de Noir have surprised with good freshness and the reds show great promise with lower alcohols.
